TREASURER REPORT	\$129,384.26 in general account. Reports were handed out and please research any discrepancies. Unidentified funds will be incorporated into the General Fund as of tomorrow. PRESIDENT REPORT	Legal defense fund has been paid. Storage pavilion for Magnolia complex has been ordered and will be installed before end of March 2011. Baseball diamonds and backstop construction at MES have been completed. We are expecting no layoffs for P&R staff but county has asked for 3% of previously approved budget to be returned.
