Few programs still show negative balance need to get this taken
care of.

working with her. She has sent out cancellations for schools. Her

everyday. As part of the reforest program they will be planting

Presidents Report : capital Budget slim to none. Hazel discussed
the desperate need of storage in our area they have approved the
containers like football used to be placed where needed. We do
have storage at Joppa Elem. Patty and Sonia will check to see
what kind of space it is and when it will be available for use.
Need representation at the county council meeting on May 18th
and 25th programs need to put it out to parents to go and make

sure no more funding gets cut. Spaghetti Dinner to benefit Paul Yanney and his wife on Oct 15th. John Nornal from HDG rec has put out a \$100 challenge to each area for a donation for the Yanney's we have agreed to match it and raise our donation to \$250.00. Danny Jahn and Hazel tried to bring up the lacrosse issues of 17yr old being on the 13-14 squads went unanswered as they decided to wait to hear from each council on it . Hopefully more to come on this topic. Joppatowne is the only area to vote on this issue.

Women's fitness has come and asked to be reinstated. We have explained our issue to them and advised that they need to put together a new board, budget and instructor in place, they need to read over all of jrc policies for requesting checks deposits of money etc. They need to have someone at the meetings each month.
